Questioned on the subject on Monday, the Premier (Mr. E. G. Theodore) said that the Wheat Board was now in direct communication with the State Government Insurance Commissioner on this subject.

**A Serious Charge.**—At the Mitchell Police Court on Monday, 18th instant, and on Thursday last, William Henry Fraser appeared before Mr. A. B. Gibson, P.M., charged with having committed rape on Lora Elizabeth Woods on the 21st July last. Sub-inspector O'Hara prosecuted, and Mr. J. P. O'Sullivan appeared for the accused.
