BUSH FIRES RECUR

WOOLGOOLGA PLANTATIONS DAMAGED.

Bush fires, which caused damage to plantations in Woolgoolga last week, flared up again on Tuesday with disastrous results to two plantations. Messrs. A. Puho and W. Richards being the sufferers.

Despite the strenuous efforts of firefighters, the flames, fanned by a strong wind swept through and severely damaged about two acres of the best portion of Mr. Puho's plantation.
