

Sent to Gaol For Unlawful Possession

A 62-year-old Russian mechanic, Nicholas Charles Uppeneek, of Magill road, Stepney, in the Adelaide Police Court today was sentenced to two months' imprisonment for having been in unlawful possession of 11 files and some solder.

The Assistant Police Prosecutor (Mr. Bond) said that all the material had been stolen from the works of Richards Industries Ltd., where he was employed.

Uppeneek admitted that, for the past seven months, he had been taking materials from the factory and using them in his secondhand shop at Magill road, Stepney. The goods were recovered by the police after a search of his shop and car.
