

LABOURER RUN OVER BY TRAIN

KALGOORLIE, Sat—Dead body of Gustav Nyman was found badly mutilated on the railway line between Lakewood and Kamballie early yesterday morning by train crew returning to Lakewood after delivering a rake of firewood at Kamballie station.

When about half a mile from Kamballie the train crew found Nyman's body, which had been dragged a considerable distance.

Nyman was a native of Finland about 50 years of age, and single. He was a labourer employed by the Lakewood Firewood Company. He was apparently walking along the line from Boulder to Lakewood when struck by the train.

Train crew were enginedriver Joseph McNally, fireman Charles Purdue, and guard Frank Seymour.
