

BAKER'S CREEK ROBBERIES ACCUSED BEFORE THE COURT.

STARTLING DISCLOSURES EXPECTED.

Sydney, December 12.

In connection with the alleged gold amalgam robberies from the Baker's Creek mine Thomas Smith was at Hillgrove to-day committed for trial on the charge of stealing gold amalgam; and John Stonehouse, watchmaker, and Isaac Woolfe, shoemaker, were also committed for trial for receiving gold amalgam.

Thomas Peter Kenney, jeweller, failed to answer to his bail on a similar charge, and his case and that of Robert Shaw, jeweller, were postponed till to-morrow.

The charge against John Lewis of stealing gold amalgam was withdrawn.

The accused were allowed heavy bail.

Other cases will be proceeded with to-morrow, when startling disclosures are expected.
