

ALLEGED BREACH OF THE INSOLVENCY ACT.

Aaron Traub, aged 21 years, described as a native of Russia, appeared at the City Police Court on Saturday, before Mr. G. P. M. Murray, P.M., charged that on the 10th October, at Toowoomba, he failed to deliver up to the trustee of the property of an insolvent, named Marcus Jacobius, the sum of £9 10s., received by him from Dahlin and Thackeray, and also one card of penknives, with intent to defraud the creditors of the insolvent. Senior Sergeant Short appeared to prosecute. Mr. T. E. White was also present.

Acting Sergeant Head deposed that on Friday he saw the defendant in a house in George-street, and said to him, "I have a warrant for your arrest." He then read to him the warrant he now produced. Defendant said, "Jacobius owed me £30."

On the application of Senior Sergeant Short, defendant was remanded till Friday next, bail being allowed, himself in £50, and one surety in £50.
