

STABBING AFFRAY.

OMEQO, Wednesday. -- A Russian, named Henry Adjutant, was arrested by Constable Edwards at Ensay on the charge of stabbing another foreigner, John Paulen, an Austrian. Both men were under the influence of liquor, and were travelling from Ensay to Little River Station, where they were employed. A carrier, named Winnett, who was on the road at the time, gave them a lift, but on account of a wrangle between the two he ordered them out of his waggon. After alighting the altercation was resumed, and blows struck. Adjutant drew a knife, and stabbed Paulen in the left side just below the lung. Adjutant was arrested by Constable Edwards, and was conveyed to the Omeo lock-up, and was brought before the local Bench this morning, when he was remanded till Thursday. A further remand will be asked for, in order that the injured man, who was taken to the Omeo Hospital, may give evidence.
