

## **FIRE IN THE CITY.**

An outbreak of fire occurred at Mr. Samuel Paltie's Pawnbroker's Shop, 130 Liverpool-street, Sydney, this morning owing to a light being thrown down. The brigade received the alarm at 7.15 a.m., and were on the scene before the flames secured a good hold, and they extinguished them with buckets of water. A portion of the stock in the front shop was damaged by fire and water. Mr. Paltie was burnt about the left hand and wrist and first aid was rendered by the M.F.B. The premises were owned by Mr. Cohen (Raine and Horne, agents), and the stock and fittings were insured for £420 in the Australian Mutual Insurance Company.
