

## RUSSIANS' PROTEST.

### WILL JOIN IN THE FIGHT.

A meeting of the Russian Club was held at Port Pirie West yesterday afternoon, when Mr. S. Radetsky presided over an attendance of between 40 and 50 members. After discussion the following resolution was carried unanimously :—

“That this meeting of Russian workers in Port Pirie regard the attitude of the authorities in Port Pirie as tyrannical in trying to prevent the I.W.W. from speaking in the streets while allowing other bodies to hold their meetings in the streets; that we show our internationality and identity of interests by taking our places in the fight to help the I.W.W. in their struggle; that we call on other working class organisations to take their places in the fight for the right to express their ideas in the streets, for which their forefathers fought and sacrificed their lives; and that a copy of this resolution be sent to the Australian Press and Labor bodies.”
