

## KILLED IN ACTION.



**PRIVATE JOHN AMOLIN.**

Private John Amolin whose death in the Dardanelles was reported in the 87th casualty list, was born in Riga, on the Baltic (Russia), but had lived in Broken Hill for six years previous to enlistment. He was 26 years of age. He had worked in the Central mine as a miner, and left for the front on March 30, 1915, with the 4th Reinforcements of the 16th Battalion. Private Amolin was killed on August 23 by shrapnel. He had boarded in South Broken Hill with Mrs. Grigg, of Moriah-street. His personal friend and companion, Private Letcher, was killed in the Central mine after a period of

in the Central mine after a period of guard duty at Largs Bay. Private Amolin was a member of the Alma Lodge of Druids. His parents live at Riga, his birthplace.
