

## STABBED TO DEATH.

### RUSSIAN CONVICTED OF MAN- SLAUGHTER.

SYDNEY, March 20.

Effin Rogashow, aged 31, a Russian, was placed on trial at the Central Criminal Court to-day on a charge of having murdered a man whose name is unknown.

The case for the prosecution was to the effect that Rogashow, who at the time was a member of the Expeditionary Forces, was drinking with a seaman in a hotel in Oxford-street. They went to a lavatory, where they had a dispute, during which, it was alleged, Rogashow stabbed the sailor with a knife. The sailor was taken to St. Vincent's Hospital, where he died an hour after admission.

Rogashow, in his defence, said that on the day of the alleged offence he got very drunk. He remembered very little until next morning, and had no recollection of having been in the sailor's company.

The jury gave a verdict of manslaughter, and Rogashow was remanded for sentence.
