Six persons were fined for drunkenness.

Ivan Miconi, a soldier, who was released on a charge of drunkenness in Archer street, North Adelaide, on the previous day, was further charged with having used indecent language on the same occasion. The defendant said that he could not plead until he saw a doctor, as he was ill. The defendant was ordered to pay a fine of £3, in default one month's imprisonment.
