

#### ALIEN'S FALSE ANSWERS.

At Newcastle Police Court this morning, before Mr. C. F. Butler, S.M., Jacob Wolfson (26), labourer, on remand, was charged under the War Precautions Act with having given false and misleading answers to questions put to him by an alien registration officer. Defendant pleaded guilty.

Constable Ravelli said that defendant had registered in Melbourne on March 1, 1917, as Jacob Lavine, a native of Russia, but witness had found that his name was Wolfson. In Tasmania he had used another name.

A fine of £3 was imposed, the alternative being 14 days' imprisonment.
