OCTOBER'S ADDITIONS.

The 340th casualty list, published on October 5, brought grief to a Nambour family of a mother and two daughters, the name of Pte. Johannes Kotkamaa being second on the list of "killed in action" (19.8.17). Although he enlisted from North Arm, his early youth had been spent at Highworth, near Nambour.

Next list, on October 13, included none from this district in its 152 Queenslanders, but its successor on the 19th mentioned Pte. Wm. Edward Smith, of Montville.

Next day, Pte. Albert Edward Linnett, of Maleny, was second on the list of those who died of wounds (21. 9.17).

List 314, on Oct. 23 included as wounded another Montville lad, Dvr. Fredk. Cecil Brown; also Pte. Bernard O'Brien of Pomona.

A big list on Oct. 25 also passed by this district.

The 29th saddened Cooroy by including among those who died of wounds Pte. Cyril Eric Moorhead, son of the well known storekeeper of that town.

The wounded listed on the following day included Pte. Wm. Gosling, of Bribie Island (previously reported ill, second occasion), and Pte. Harry Kemp of Caboolture.
