

FREMANTLE POLICE COURT.

Disorderly Conduct.—As the result of a free fight which occurred on Saturday night on a vessel at present in port five seamen, Joseph McGuire, Jacob H. Levet, Frederick van Poepelo, John Davies, and Owen Williams, were charged with being drunk and disorderly. Fines ranging from 2s. to 5s., with costs, were imposed. On a further charge of assaulting the arresting sergeant of police, Levet was fined £1. with 5s. costs, while van Poepelo was fined a further 5s. for resisting arrest.

Fighting.—Edward Brown and Herbert Anderson were each fined 2s., with 3s. costs, for fighting in South-terrace on Saturday night.
