
'RUSSLAN CITIZENS' ASSOCIATION.

A meeting of Russians resident in South Australia was held at the Nationalisation of Banks Lecture Hall, No. 20 Pulteney street, on Saturday night. The object was to form an association of persons of Russian birth (of all nationalities) or of Russian parentage. The aims of the association are to link up with similar Russian organisations within the Commonwealth, to assist new arrivals of Russian nationality, the establishment of a Russian library, and the fostering of social intercourse between all Russians. A provisional committee was appointed, consisting of:— President, Mr. L. Yonnidis; vice-president, Mr. J. Peskin; secretary, Mr. A. Golud; committee, Messrs. I. Miconi, H. S. Cohen, P. Borisov, and M. Dossoeff, and Madam Yonnidis. It was decided to meet again at an early date, which will be advertised.
