

UNLAWFULLY WOUNDING

AN UNUSUAL SENTENCE

DETENTION AT WOOROLOO.

Although His Honor the Chief Justice passed sentence of nine months' imprisonment upon Andrew Kairi, a returned soldier, in the Criminal Court this morning, an instruction was given to the Crown Law authorities that he was to be sent to the Wooroloo Sanatorium, he having contracted tuberculosis whilst on active service. His Honor said that at the time the attack upon the man Green was made by the accused, resulting in his wounds, aKiri was apparently very drunk. He hoped that accused's period of detention would not only result in curing him of his consumption, but that he would mend his ways and keep away from the drink.
