### **Russian at Maitland**

Charles Pulpe, a Russian, was fined 40s, in default seven days' imprisonment, by Mr. Gale, P.M., at Maitland Police Court this morning, on a charge of having failed to register under the War Precautions Act as an alien. It was stated that Pulpe was re-arrested on the present charge after having served 14 days in gaol for having lit fires to the danger of public safety, and it took the authorities from January 2 to the present time to issue the necessary permission to prosecute. Defendant stated that he was registered in Queensland, but had his certificate destroyed by fire.
