### DAMAGING SHOW CASE.

Bernard Remez, Gurwood-street, Wagga, proceeded against James Edward M'Alister (28), on a charge of maliciously damaging a glass show case to the extent of £2 on Friday, February 20.

Defendant pleaded not guilty.

After exhaustive evidence was given of the occurrence which led up to the breaking of the case, Mr. M'Mahon imposed a fine on defendant of £2, in default one month in Albury gaol, and ordered him to pay £2 damages. Mr. M'Mahon remarked that as long as complainant, who was a naturalised Russian, was a member of a British community, and behaved himself, he would receive justice at the hands of the court. It appeared that certain people mistook his nationality, and made a point of persecuting him.
