

GOODS FALSELY DESCRIBED **VICTORIAN DRAPER FINED.**

At Northcote (Vic), William Zmood, draper, was charged with having exposed for sale goods to which a false trade description had been applied.

An inspector under the Goods Act deposed that he saw displayed in the window at defendant's premises a pair of trousers labelled "All wool trousers, 12/6." Witness purchased them.

On being submitted to the Government Analyst, it was found that the material in the garment contained 31 per cent. of cotton.

In his defence, Zmood said the ticket was attached to the trousers by mistake when he (defendant) was absent from the shop. A fine of £5, with £2/4/ costs, was imposed.

The mutilated body of a young woman whose head had been severed by a train was found on the railway line between South Yarra and Richmond on Wednesday night. The identity of the woman has not yet been established.
