

PORT ADELAIDE: Thursday, February 8.

An application was made for an award under the Workmen's Compensation Act, 1911 to 1920, arising out of the death of August Arreta, a wharf labourer, at Port Adelaide on November 24. Deceased was working on the collier Yarra on November 24, when he fell into the hold and was killed. He was a Russian, who had been in Australia for about 14 years, and had no dependants. The Court found that there were no persons dependent on deceased, and ordered the payment of £20 as funeral expenses. The Public Trustee was the applicant.
