

## MOTOR ACCIDENTS.

### CRIPPLED MAN INJURED.

Fate has been unkind to Nicholas Kotzebuc, 43, laborer, of 540 Lonsdale-street, city, who for a second time was compelled to visit the hospital on Saturday as the result of injury by accidents. Kotzebuc recently sustained a fractured ankle, and he was getting about on crutches. Shortly after 1 p.m. he was crossing Lonsdale-street in Swanston-street, on the west side of the latter thoroughfare, when he was struck and knocked down by a motor car driven by James Stewart, of Marshall-street, Ivanhoe, which was proceeding along Lonsdale-street. The driver of the car made an effort to avoid Kotzebuc by swerving to the right, but the mudguard struck him and he was dragged along for some paces. On being conveyed to the Melbourne Hospital, where he was admitted, Kotzebuc was found to be suffering from abrasions on the head and face, fractured ribs and shock.
