

## RETURNED SOLDIER MISSING.

While fishing at La Perouse between Bare Island and Henry Head early yesterday morning, James Doran, of 17 Elgar-street, Glebe, discovered a man's coat and hat lying on the shore, at a place known as Brown's rock. The matter was reported to the Daceyville police, who discovered in the pockets of the coat a military discharge bearing the name of William Kolesnikov, regimental number 2681, attached to the 55th Battalion. The discharge showed that the man belonged to Sydney. A war pension certificate was also found which indicated that the last cash payment had been made on December 21, 1922.

A search for the owner of the property was made, but so far without success.
