

Official Correspondence.

Sir Austin Chapman is in receipt of the following letters from the Postmaster-General:—

“ With reference to previous correspondence relative to representations made by Mr. A. M. Tober, Perth Avenue, Canberra for the provision of telephone facilities at Perth Avenue, I have to intimate that it is expected the line which is being erected between Canberra and Westlake (Perth Avenue) will be completed about 19/2/25. A telephone office will then be established under the designation ‘ Westlake ’.”
