

FALSE DECLARATIONS.

Pensions Applicant Imprisoned.

Before Mr. A. A. Kelley, P.M., in the City Court yesterday, John Ouchirenko, of Post-office place, South Melbourne, appeared on two charges of having made false statements in support of applications for pensions under the Repatriation Act for his wife, Clara Ouchirenko, and his child, Ruby Ouchirenko.

It was stated that in making the applications Ouchirenko declared that his wife and child had returned from England, where they had been living, and were now resident in Victoria. Evidence was called to show the declaration to be false.

Ouchirenko was sentenced to imprisonment for two months on each charge.
