DEATH FROM DROWNING.

The enquiry into the circumstances surrounding the death of Victor Ronul Sylvester Vort Ronald, whose body was recovered from the Torrens on Tuesday, was conducted by the City Coroner (Dr. W. Ramsay Smith) on Friday morning. Evidence of identification was given by the wife of the dead man, Hilda Olive Vort Ronald, who said her husband left home about midnight on the Friday prior to his body being found. He had been in a nervous state for some time. Evidence was also given by James Albert Smith and Water-Constable A. E. Nation, who recovered the body. Medical evidence was given by Dr. A. F. Lynch, who made a post-mortem examination. The finding was that the man had met his death by drowning, but there was no evidence to show how he came to be in the water.
