

## Separation Granted

Before Mr. H. M. Muirhead, S.M., and Messrs. A. Champion and J. Fowler, in No. 2 Adelaide Police Court today, Edward Peter Cheney, aged 39 years, of Little Gilbert street, Adelaide, was charged by his wife with being a person whose intemperance at times made him dangerous to others. Complainant, who was represented by Mr. J. K. Alderman, of the Children's Welfare and Public Relief Board, asked for a separation.

The allegations were found to have been proved and Mrs. Cheney was granted a separation. Cheney was ordered to pay £1 a week for the maintenance of his wife and 5/ a week for the maintenance of his youngest child.
