

CLAIM FOR COMPENSATION

In the Industrial Magistrate's Court yesterday afternoon, before Mr. J. Stewart Berge, Police Magistrate, the hearing was adjourned for a week of the case in which Johanna F. Serow, of Duke Street, Thompson Estate, applied for compensation in respect of the death of her husband, John Serow, who was employed as an engineer by the Metropolitan Milk Supply, Greater Brisbane, Ltd., and who died on December 13, 1928.

The application had been rejected by the State Insurance Commissioner. The applicant contended that her husband's death was caused by a chill contracted while going in and out of a freezing room.

Mr. A. J. Miller (Messrs. Quinlan and Miller) appeared for the applicant, and Mr. H. Martin (Crown Law Office) for the State Insurance Commissioner.
