Tweed Heads Fire

TWEED HEADS, Friday.

Early this morning the Pacific Hotel, Tweed Heads, narrowly escaped destruction. Two distinct fires were discovered in an upstairs bedroom. One outbreak was at the head of the bed and the second fire was inside a built in wardrobe in the opposite corner of the room. Later the police arrested William Frank Jaks, who gave his occupation as French polisher, and nationality Pole. He was brought before the police court this morning and remanded for eight days.
