

STOVE STOLEN

Man With Seven Children Fined

Axel Valentine Josephson, who told Mr. H. M. Muirhead, S.M., in No. 1 Adelaide Police Court this morning that he had done no work for two years, had a wife and seven children, and was in receipt of a war pension, was fined £1 with £1 5/ costs and ordered to pay £2 to the Congregational Provident Trust for having, on October 4, stolen a gas stove, the property of the trust.

Mr. J. P. Walsh, who prosecuted, said that accused lived in a house in Carrington street belonging to the trust. When he left the stove was missed. He admitted having sold it.
