

MISSING MAN SOUGHT HERE

W.A. Police Asked to Assist

Having failed to discover the whereabouts of Gerrard Marcan Skugar, aged 40, after a State-wide search, the New South Wales police have asked the police in Perth to assist them in an endeavor to locate the missing man.

According to a report received at police headquarters

police headquarters today, Skugar disappeared from his lodgings at Redfern-street, Redfern, on September 9. It is stated that he had an argument with his business partner, which appeared to worry him. Skugar, who is a returned soldier, is a fancy jewellery manufacturer.

The following description has been supplied by the New South Wales

police: Forty years of age, 5ft. 10in high, stout build, swarthy complexion and black hair. Skugar has an anchor tattooed on his thumb, a gunshot wound on the right side of his head between the eye and ear, and a small wart on the point of his nose. He is slightly deaf and walks with a shuffle.

When last seen he was wearing a navy suit, a striped grey overcoat and black shoes. He never wears a hat. He is of Polish nationality.
