

CAR FATALITY.

YASS, Tuesday.

The District Coroner (Mr. Coen) to-day found that Halme Stone, 42, of Parramatta-road, Annandale, died from injuries accidentally received on March 29 in a motor car accident on the Hume Highway, between Bowning and Bookham.

David Borszcer, who was the only other occupant of the car, said they were travelling about 45 or 50 miles an hour.

Constable G. E. White said when deceased and Borszcer topped the hill known as Conroy's Gap, on the Hume Highway, they were travelling at between 30 and 40 miles an hour. About 150 yards down the hill the driver appeared to lose control, and the car left the road, and turned over twice. In witness's opinion, the application of the brakes caused the car to swerve and leave the road. Deceased was thrown through the roof of the car. The body was 15 feet from the car.
