

Man With Broken Legs Dies

Another victim of the road, 59-year-old Fritz Schilling died in the Perth Hospital today from injuries received in an accident last night.

Schilling was taken to hospital with both legs fractured and extensive lacerations to the face and head.

Soon after admission his name was placed on the danger list early today. He died a few minutes after 10 o'clock.

Schilling was injured when he was struck by a car in William-street, Cannington, as he walked along the roadway shortly before midnight.

Cyril Dunnell, of Kelmscott, driver of the car, told the police that he saw Schilling walking towards him, but that as he swerved to avoid him, Schilling seemed to step in the same direction.

Another pedestrian attended to Schilling while the car driver phoned for a St. John ambulance.
