

## MAN FATALLY INJURED

There were many accidents in the city and suburbs yesterday, one proving fatal. Civil Ambulance attended more than 12 calls in the peak period. Few of the injured required hospital treatment.

Struck by a motor bus at the corner of Flinders and Swanston streets at 5.5 p.m. yesterday, Mr Olo George Saren, Cubitt-street, Richmond, suffered serious injuries, and was admitted to Prince Henry's Hospital, where he died later.

When a wall collapsed on him at the works of the Parkinson Stove Co., Sunshine-road, Footscray, Mr. Joseph Pearson, 65 years, of Hoffman-street, West Brunswick, received spinal injuries and suffered shock. He was admitted to the Royal Melbourne Hospital.
