

PEDESTRIAN HURT.

Hit by Car While Crossing Road.

When he walked from behind a stationary tram in Beaufort-street, Mt. Lawley, early last night, Samuel Rappeport (58), of 26 Alvan-street, Mt. Lawley, was hit by a car. He was admitted to the Royal Perth Hospital suffering from concussion and lacerations to the head.

It was reported to Traffic Constable G. Pettersson that Rappeport was hit by a car which was being driven southwards in Beaufort-street by Thomas Reginald Lamb, of 161 Sixth-avenue, Mt. Lawley. The injured man had come from behind a north-bound tram which had halted at the corner of Queen's-crescent and started to cross the road to the east side. He was apparently hit by the whole of the left side of the car as the front and rear bumpers and both door handles were damaged. Rappeport was taken to a nearby doctor's surgery from where a St. John ambulance took him to hospital.
