

Exploit New Gold Field

SYDNEY, May 9.—A retired 66-year-old Sydney business man, Louis Brodsky, of Bondi, wants six men to join him in exploiting a Queensland goldfield.

Brodsky said today that war interrupted his plans to open up the field, which is near Pentland, about 150 miles south-west of Townsville.

Brodsky said: "I know that gold is there. I have dug it out. Experts' reports show that the lode I discovered will yield more than a third of an ounce to the ton." He said that the lode had been traced for more than 1500 feet and had great possibilities. He added that he and six men who joined him would each put in £500 to buy the equipment. They would then work the mine themselves.

Brodsky added: 'Anyone interested in joining us can have a look at the field before he thinks about putting his money into it.'
